

THINGS TO DO AROUND ASAKUSA AREA



SENSOJI TEMPLE

The oldest temple in Tokyo, said to have been built in 628. It is famous for its main Kaminarimon Gate, where a giant lantern hangs. The temple is popular with both locals and tourists alike with its signature Sanja festival (held on the third weekend of every May).

AZUMA BRIDGE

Stretching across the Sumida River and connecting the Sensoji Temple area with Tokyo Skytree, where you can have a nice view when the Skytree is light up at night or the Asahi beer's symbol.

ASAKUSA CULTURE TOURIST INFORMATION

Easily access to free guided tours, currency exchange and an information desk not only around Tokyo but also other places such as Osaka and Kyoto. From the observation deck, you can have the best views of Sensoji without having to jostle through the crowds.

ASAKUSA HANAYASHIKI

Oldest amusement park in Tokyo with a roller coaster and other high-speed rides, suitable for family with small kids. Highly recommend trying cute Panda ride here.

ASAKUSA MOKUBAKAN
